1. The DEADLINE to submit all scholarship applications and supporting documents is **April 15, 2017 @ 5:00 p.m.** (Mountain Time).
2. Refer to the criteria below for eligibility requirements. Refer to the application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Please note that incomplete applications will not be considered.

Purpose:

Award Components:

Each year, the El Paso NAWIC Chapter # 248 will select a recipient who will receive a \$1,000.00 scholarship. The scholarship is intended to reward students engaged in service, who are majoring in a construction-related field.

Award Criteria:

1. Applicant must be enrolled (or accepted) in an accredited college, university, or trade school.
2. Applicant must be majoring in a construction-related field.
3. Applicant must have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
4. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident with a permanent resident ID card or current passport.

Application Process:

1. All Applicants must submit the following items:
 - a. A completed scholarship application form;
 - b. An official school transcript from your most recent school;
 - c. Two Letters of Recommendation (at least one must be from an Instructor or Professor); and
 - d. **A one-page, double-spaced essay, describing your academic and career goals and explaining why you are interested in pursuing a construction-related career.**
2. If selected from qualifying applications, the applicant may be required to participate in a live interview with the El Paso NAWIC Chapter 248 committee.
3. You will be notified by mail within sixty (60) days of the application deadline regarding the status of your application.
4. Proof of acceptance or current student enrollment from an accredited college, university, or trade school is required prior to receipt of funds.
5. The deadline to submit the application and all supporting documents is **April 15, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.** (Mountain Time). Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
